With the new and improved downloadable app for iPhone, iPod Touch, iPad, and Android devices, credit union members can access their accounts almost anywhere. And, you can enjoy this service knowing that you're using a mobile banking app protected by mobile banking security measures, including state-of-the-art encryption, firewalls, and secure logins.

However, with identity theft always a concern, it can never hurt to take some additional general precautions when using mobile banking (or accessing any other online accounts). To maximize your safety when using your Smartphone, follow these rules:

- * Keep your personal info personal. Never share your PIN, password or security question with anyone or save it on your phone.
- * Password-protect your phone. This way, possible perpetrators cannot access your info if it's lost or stolen.
- * Call your credit union right away in the event your phone is lost or stolen. Using a computer, change your account passwords immediately!

* Keep routine tabs on your accounts. This way you'll notice any unusual changes right away.
